





News & Notes From The R&P Range

Welcoming Guests the Right Way

One of the great benefits of our Rifle & Pistol Range is the opportunity to share it with family, friends, and prospective members. Each voting member is permitted to bring up to two guests at a time. Guest fees are \$10 per person and cover access to the entire Chapter property for the day.

Sponsors are responsible for ensuring their guests understand and follow all range rules. Guests must sign the liability waiver before shooting, and they must remain under the direct supervision of their host member while on the firing line. As always, the instructions of the Range Safety Officer (RSO) are to be followed without exception.

Welcoming guests properly does more than maintain safety. It introduces new people to our Chapter and helps strengthen the League for the future. Many of today's members initially visited as guests, including me.

Volunteer as an RSO

Our range is staffed entirely by volunteers. To remain open as much as possible, we need more members to step up as RSOs. When shifts go unfilled, the range must close, and that affects all of us. If you enjoy your time at the range and want to ensure it's available to others, please consider training and serving as an RSO. It's one of the most direct and rewarding ways you can contribute to our Chapter, and shifts are only 4.5 hours long.



Ladies Only Introductory Pistol Course

Join us on Saturday, September 27th, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for our Ladies Only Introductory Pistol Course. This class is designed for new shooters or those looking to build confidence and reinforce the fundamentals in a supportive setting.

The cost is \$15 for members and \$25 for non-members. Ammunition will be provided for our Chapter pistols. Participants are welcome to bring their own firearm, but must provide their own ammo.
