The Fort Wayne Chapter of the Izaak Walton League of America offers its members various outdoor recreation activities. These include fishing, hiking, primitive camping, wildlife observation, archery, skeet and trap, rifle and pistol ranges. These facilities are available to all Chapter members; however, due to insurance, maintenance, and upkeep costs associated with the rifle & pistol range, an annual fee of \$50.00 per membership is required from those who choose to have access to these specific ranges. The range fee is not prorated at any time during the year.

If you are a new member or if your membership has lapsed for at least two years and you apply for membership on or after November 1st, your membership will span the period including November and December of the current year, plus the subsequent twelve months of the following year.

A new member applying for membership between July 1 and October 31 will enjoy dues prorated at one-half the annual rate since their membership will expire on December 31st of that same year.

 processing charge added to the dues and/or range card fees applied when paying online.
