All membership applications are carefully reviewed and approved by our Board of Directors to ensure alignment with our chapter's values and mission. In the unlikely event that your application is not accepted, any payment submitted will be promptly refunded in full. We appreciate your interest and commitment to our Chapter and Izaak Walton League.

Before holding membership in the Fort Wayne Chapter, one must first be a member of the National and Indiana Division of the Izaak Walton League of America, Inc. The term "dues" in the document and the amount shown include all required entities.

The Fort Wayne Chapter of the Izaak Walton League of America offers its members various outdoor recreation activities. These include fishing, hiking, primitive camping, wildlife observation, archery, skeet and trap, rifle and pistol ranges. These facilities are available to all Chapter members; however, due to insurance, maintenance, and upkeep costs associated with the rifle & pistol range, an annual fee of \$50.00 per membership is required from those who choose to have access to these specific ranges. The range fee is not prorated at any time during the year.

If you are a new member or if your membership has lapsed for at least two years and you apply for membership on or after November 1st, your membership will span the period including November and December of the current year, plus the subsequent twelve months of the following year.

A new member applying for membership between July 1 and October 31 will enjoy dues prorated at one-half the annual rate since their membership will expire on December 31st of that same year.

- Place application and dues payment in a sealed envelope marked “**Membership Director**” and deposit it in the countertop drop slot in the Chapter House
- Send your application via US Postal Service, pay with a check or money order (**DO NOT SEND CASH**). Send the appropriate dues and range fee amount to: **Treasurer, Fort Wayne Chapter, IWLA , 8014 Acorn Hill Cove, Fort Wayne, IN 46804**
- You may also submit your application and pay your dues to the **Range Safety Officer** on duty at the **Rifle & Pistol Range**. Be sure to get a receipt for your dues payment and safeguard it, as you may need to produce it for verification at a later date.
- Complete the Online Application and make an online payment. **Please note:** there will be an additional processing charge added to the dues and/or range card fees applied when paying online.

Our Chapter has no paid employees and is totally dependent on members who volunteer their time and talents to manage and maintain the facility grounds and structures. In minimal cases, outside contractors are engaged to perform tasks that are not within the capabilities of our membership. As a member, you are asked to volunteer a minimum of 15 hours per year by participation in our workdays and to volunteer your assistance at other times, and in any way you can, to help support and nurture our Chapter.
